

Educational Opportunities for Lymphoedema Assistants (LA) and Lymphoedema Assistant Practitioners (LAP)

Continual professional development in a vital part of providing high quality care. Below are some of the educational opportunities that we have identified that are available to LAs and LAPs. This list is not exhaustive and we would welcome information regarding additional ongoing training opportunities.

General Qualifications:

- The Royal College of Nursing course finder for HCA education is a useful tool. https://www.healthcareers.nhs.uk/
- The level 3 QCF Diploma in Healthcare has superseded the NVQ 3. Anyone with qualifications lower than Level 4 will usually receive the QCF diploma for free. At Level 3 you must be carrying out regular, unsupervised, patient observations to be able to complete one of the compulsory clinical units. You would also need your manager's support for any study leave you need to attend classes should you meet the entry criteria. This can be checked at an initial meeting with the college team.
- Foundation Degrees in Health and Social Care are the most common route to becoming and assistant practitioner and are widely available throughout the country.

Training includes a 3-day Support Worker training and optional 1 day Support Worker review and Fill and Flush Manual Lymphatic Drainage training.
